

(2) Has a shipping weight of its chassis and battery, as certified by the manufacturer, of more than 3/4 ton.

(b) On application, the Administration shall issue a Class E "farm truck registration" to any applicant who certifies:

(1) That the applicant is a farmer; and

(2) That the vehicle for which the application is made is a farm truck, specifying its proposed use.

(c) For each vehicle registered under this section, the annual registration fee is based on the maximum gross vehicle weight, as follows:

Maximum Gross Weight Limit (in Pounds)	Fee (Per 1,000 Pounds or Fraction Thereof)
10,000 (minimum) -	
55,000 (maximum)	\$2

(d) A vehicle registered under this section may not be used[:

(1) For] FOR hire[; or].

[(2) In] (E) A VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE USED IN any manner other than as a farm truck.

[(e)] (F) (1) Any person who obtains a farm truck registration through misrepresentation, false pretenses, or fraud is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$50.

(2) Any person who uses a vehicle registered under this section in any way prohibited by this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$10.

(3) On a second or subsequent conviction of any person for a violation of any provision of this [subsection] SECTION, the Administration shall revoke the registration and the right of further registration of that vehicle as a farm truck for a period of 1 year.

(a) In this section, "farm truck tractor" means a farm vehicle that is a Class F (tractor) vehicle.
