(G) A PERSON OTHER THAN THE OPERATOR OF A MOTORCYCLE MAY NOT RIDE IN A POSITION THAT INTERFERES WITH THE OPERATION OR CONTROL OF THE MOTORCYCLE OR THE VIEW OF THE OPERATOR.

21-1404.

- (A) Traffic using any vehicular crossing shall obey any lawful sign[, order, signal, or direction by voice, sign, or hand of any authorized employee of the vehicular crossing].
- (B) TRAFFIC USING ANY VEHICULAR CROSSING SHALL OBEY ANY LAWFUL ORDER OF ANY AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEE OF THE VEHICULAR CROSSING.
- (C) TRAFFIC USING ANY VEHICULAR CROSSING SHALL OBEY ANY LAWFUL SIGNAL OF ANY AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEE OF THE VEHICULAR CROSSING.
- (D) TRAFFIC USING ANY VEHICULAR CROSSING SHALL OBEY ANY LAWFUL DIRECTION BY VOICE, SIGN, OR HAND OF ANY AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEE OF THE VEHICULAR CROSSING.

21-1405.

- (A) Pedestrians [and bicycles] may not use any vehicular crossing.
 - (B) BICYCLES MAY NOT USE ANY VEHICULAR CROSSING.

21-1408.

- (A) Except at the lawful direction of an authorized employee of the vehicular crossing, a vehicular turn may not be made(:
- (1) In] IN any area where turns are prohibited by signs[; or].
- [(2) At] (B) EXCEPT AT THE LAWFUL DIRECTION OF AN AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEE OF THE VEHICULAR CROSSING, A VEHICULAR TURN MAY NOT BE MADE AT crossovers provided for emergency vehicles.

21-1413.

- (A) A person may not fail or refuse to pay the prescribed toll [or attempt to evade the payment of the toll] at any highway or vehicular crossing for which the payment of a toll is fixed.
- (B) A PERSON MAY NOT ATTEMPT TO EVADE THE PAYMENT OF THE TOLL AT ANY HIGHWAY OR VEHICULAR CROSSING FOR WHICH THE PAYMENT OF A TOLL IS FIXED.
