

(G) A PERSON OTHER THAN THE OPERATOR OF A MOTORCYCLE MAY NOT RIDE IN A POSITION THAT INTERFERES WITH THE OPERATION OR CONTROL OF THE MOTORCYCLE OR THE VIEW OF THE OPERATOR.

21-1404.

(A) Traffic using any vehicular crossing shall obey any lawful sign[, order, signal, or direction by voice, sign, or hand of any authorized employee of the vehicular crossing].

(B) TRAFFIC USING ANY VEHICULAR CROSSING SHALL OBEY ANY LAWFUL ORDER OF ANY AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEE OF THE VEHICULAR CROSSING.

(C) TRAFFIC USING ANY VEHICULAR CROSSING SHALL OBEY ANY LAWFUL SIGNAL OF ANY AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEE OF THE VEHICULAR CROSSING.

(D) TRAFFIC USING ANY VEHICULAR CROSSING SHALL OBEY ANY LAWFUL DIRECTION BY VOICE, SIGN, OR HAND OF ANY AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEE OF THE VEHICULAR CROSSING.

21-1405.

(A) Pedestrians [and bicycles] may not use any vehicular crossing.

(B) BICYCLES MAY NOT USE ANY VEHICULAR CROSSING.

21-1408.

(A) Except at the lawful direction of an authorized employee of the vehicular crossing, a vehicular turn may not be made[:

(1) In] IN any area where turns are prohibited by signs[; or].

[(2) At] (B) EXCEPT AT THE LAWFUL DIRECTION OF AN AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEE OF THE VEHICULAR CROSSING, A VEHICULAR TURN MAY NOT BE MADE AT crossovers provided for emergency vehicles.

21-1413.

(A) A person may not fail or refuse to pay the prescribed toll [or attempt to evade the payment of the toll] at any highway or vehicular crossing for which the payment of a toll is fixed.

(B) A PERSON MAY NOT ATTEMPT TO EVADE THE PAYMENT OF THE TOLL AT ANY HIGHWAY OR VEHICULAR CROSSING FOR WHICH THE PAYMENT OF A TOLL IS FIXED.
