

DAYS AFTER THE END OF THE QUARTER DURING WHICH (1), (2), OR (3) ABOVE OCCURRED.

(d) The reports filed in accordance with this section shall be treated as confidential records UNDER § 10-624(C) OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE. [The reports shall be released only for bona fide research or educational purposes.] Reports relating to physicians [may] SHALL be released to the State Board of Medical Examiners; reports relating to hospitals and blood banks [may] SHALL be released to the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene; and reports relating to nurses, dentists, doctors of osteopathy, podiatrists, optometrists, and chiropractors [may] SHALL be released to the appropriate licensing board for such health providers. [The recipient of the report in its sole discretion shall determine the validity of any request for the reports.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.
