

the matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State Treasurer and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. If this evidence is not presented by June 1, 1988, the proceeds of the loan shall be applied to the purposes authorized in § 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

(6) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the County Executive and County Council of Prince George's County shall present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a certificate of need for the Prince George's General Hospital and Medical Center project provided in this Act has been obtained from the Maryland Health Resources Planning Commission.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 494

(House Bill 791)

AN ACT concerning

Health Insurance - Nonduplication Provisions

FOR the purpose of prohibiting any nonprofit health service plan, health insurance policy, or group or blanket health insurance policy from containing nonduplication provisions or provisions requiring coordinating coverage with certain individual specified disease policies; and generally relating to health insurance policies.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 48A - Insurance Code

361F.
