

paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of issue of the bonds.

(5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore and the National Aquarium in Baltimore, Inc., jointly shall provide at least an equal and matching fund of ~~\$10,000,000~~ \$3,500,000. No part of an applicant's matching fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act, except for architects' and engineering fees. In case of any dispute as to what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter, and the Board's decision is final. The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore and the National Aquarium in Baltimore, Inc., have until June 1, 1988, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that the matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State Treasurer and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. If this evidence is not presented by June 1, 1988, the proceeds of the loan shall be applied to the purposes authorized in § 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1986.

(House Bill 1117)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Hebrew Home of Greater Washington
MC 607-86

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of ~~\$2,000,000~~ \$1,000,000 \$500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Hebrew Home of Greater Washington for the purpose of the acquisition of land for and the planning, design, construction, and equipping of a congregate housing and supportive service project for elderly citizens to be located in Montgomery County, subject to the requirement that the Hebrew Home of Greater Washington provide at least an equal and matching fund of a certain kind for the same purpose by a certain date;
