

CHAPTER 532

(House Bill 1155)

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County - Property Tax Credit -
Prince George's County Parks and Recreation Foundation
PG 408-86

FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of Prince George's County to grant, by law, a credit against the county or special district property tax imposed on certain real property owned by the Prince George's County Parks and Recreation Foundation.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(c) The governing body of Prince George's County may grant, by law, a property tax credit under this section against the county property tax or special district tax imposed on:
