FIDE CIVIC ASSOCIATION OR HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION BY ANY DULY ELECTED OFFICER OF THE ASSOCIATION REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THAT INDIVIDUAL IS A-BAWYER AN ATTORNEY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

## CHAPTER 541

(House Bill 1169)

AN ACT concerning

Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission - Minority Business Contracts PG/MC 46-86

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission to recognize certification programs of minority business enterprises by-agencies-other-than--the--Department of--Pransportation of the State or a county under certain circumstances.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 29 - Washington Suburban Sanitary District Section 3-102(d)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1983 Replacement Volume and 1985 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 29 - Washington Suburban Sanitary District 3-102.

- (d) (1) In this subsection "minority business enterprise" means a minority business enterprise as defined in Article 21, Section 8-601 of the Code.
- (2) By resolution and by implementing rules and regulations, the WSSC shall establish a mandatory minority business utilization program to facilitate the participation of responsible certified minority business enterprises in contracts awarded by the WSSC in accordance with competitive bidding procedures.
