2-108.

(b) Each of the judges of the court for Allegany County shall receive as an annual compensation the sum of [\$1,800] \$3,000. Each judge shall also receive an expense allowance in the amount of [\$300] \$600 annually, to be paid at the rate of [\$25] \$50 monthly.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35, of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Orphans' Court Judges of Allegany County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Orphans' Court Judges of Allegany County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

## CHAPTER 22

(Senate Bill 247)

AN ACT concerning

Division of Correction - Work Release Authorization

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Commissioner of Correction to designate a person to review and act upon recommendations for work release status.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

700A.
