- (I) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE EXPRESSLY PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, IMPOSE TRAINING OR OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AS A PRECONDITION TO RECEIPT OF FUNDS; OR
- WITH STATE FUNDS HAVE A USEFUL LIFE EXPECTANCY OF GREATER THAN 1 YEAR.
- (d) (l) State funds provided under this section may only be used for any 1 or more of the following:
- (i) Acquisition or rehabilitation of fire or rescue apparatus, including ambulances;
- (ii) Acquisition or rehabilitation of capital equipment used in connection with fire or rescue apparatus; and
- (iii) Rehabilitation of facilities used primarily to house fire fighting apparatus, equipment, ambulances, and rescue vehicles.
- (2) State funds provided under this section may not be used for any of the following:
 - (i) Administrative costs;
- (ii) Compensation or fringe benefits to employees or members of county governments, or fire, rescue, or ambulance companies;
 - (iii) Travel or meal expenses;
- (iv) Fuel, utility, or routine maintenance costs of facilities or apparatus;
- (v) Acquisition of new or replacement fire hydrants, water mains, or emergency alarm systems not installed at a fire, rescue, or ambulance facility;
 - (vi) Insurance;
 - (vii) Fund-raising activities;
- (viii) Refinancing of any debt or other obligation incurred before July 1, 1985;
- (ix) Replacement or repair of eligible items to the extent that insurance proceeds are available;
- (x) Costs associated with the "911" emergency number system; or
 - (xi) Land or interests in land.
