

## CHAPTER 590..

(House Bill 1700)

## AN ACT concerning

Maryland Transportation Authority - Transportation  
of Hazardous Material

FOR the purpose of increasing the sanctions for illegal transportation of hazardous materials across or through certain facilities of the Maryland Transportation Authority; imposing a certain penalty and a certain number of points for violation of certain prohibitions on transportation of hazardous materials; providing a certain exception; increasing a certain penalty; clarifying language and making certain changes to conform to federal law; and generally relating to transportation of hazardous materials on crossings and highways.
