- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
  - (W) (1) "RESPONSIBLE PERSON" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO:

- (3) (III) BY CONTRACT, AGREEMENT, OR OTHERWISE ARRANGED FOR DISPOSAL OR TREATMENT, OR ARRANGED WITH A TRANSPORTER FOR TRANSPORT FOR DISPOSAL OR TREATMENT, OF A CONTROLLED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE OWNED OR POSSESSED BY SUCH PERSON, BY ANY OTHER PARTY OR ENTITY, AT ANY SITE OWNED OR OPERATED BY
