providing for termination of the Compact; providing for enforcement of the provisions of the Compact; providing for certain prohibited acts; providing for compensation and clean-up during a facilities' operational and post-closure periods; providing for the severability of this Act; generally relating to the Appalachian States Low-Level Radioactive Waste Compact; and making this Act an emergency measure.

ARTICLE I DEFINITIONS

AS USED IN THE COMPACT, UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:

A. "BROKER" MEANS ANY INTERMEDIATE PERSON WHO HANDLES, TREATS, PROCESSES, STORES, PACKAGES, SHIPS OR OTHERWISE HAS RESPONSIBILITY FOR OR POSSESSES LOW-LEVEL WASTE OBTAINED FROM A GENERATOR.
