SECTION--1.---BE--IT--ENACTED--BY--THE--GENERAL--ASSEMBLY--OF
MARYLAND, That the laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article---Natural-Resources

SUBSECTION, {A} No person may not catch oysters by tongs, for
patent-tongs, or {by} diving--except during the tonging-and-diving
season from {September-15} OCTOBER-1 to March-31, inclusive,--the
following year.

{2}--{However,--in} IN the waters of Worcester County,
the tonging-and-diving-season is from January-1 to December--31,
inclusive.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That notwithstanding any other law or regulation of the
Department of Natural Resources establishing catch limits for
oysters caught by tongs, patent tongs, or diving, the following
daily catch limits for oysters apply from September 15, 1986
through September 30, 1986:

| <u>Method of Catching Oysters</u> | <u>Daily Oyster Catch Limit</u> |
|-----------------------------------|--|
| <u>Tongs</u> | <u>15 bushels per man and -100- 45 bushels per boat.</u> |
| <u>Patent Tongs</u> | <u>15 bushels per man, 45 bushels per boat that uses a single rig, and 60 bushels per boat that uses a double rig.</u> |
| <u>Diving</u> | <u>20 bushels per boat.</u> |

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall
take effect July 1, 1986.
