- (F) ACCESSORY, SHARED AND SHELTERED HOUSING PROGRAM.
- (1) THE ACCESSORY, SHARED AND SHELTERED HOUSING PROGRAM IS CREATED WITHIN THE MARYLAND HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAM.
- (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL OPERATE THE PROGRAM AND MAKE LOANS FOR REHABILITATION COSTS FOR ACCESSORY, SHARED AND SHELTERED HOUSING FROM THE FUND UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- (3) TO QUALIFY FOR AN ACCESSORY OR SHARED HOUSING LOAN THE OWNER OF A RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY:
- (I) MUST OWN THE PROPERTY FOR WHICH THE LOAN IS MADE AND RESIDE IN THE PROPERTY AFTER COMPLETION OF THE REHABILITATION;
 - (II) MUST BE A FAMILY OF LIMITED INCOME; AND
- (III) MUST USE THE PROCEEDS OF THE LOAN TO IMPLEMENT A REHABILITATION PROJECT IN ORDER TO PROVIDE SHARED HOUSING FACILITIES OR AN ACCESSORY DWELLING UNIT FOR OCCUPANCY BY A FAMILY OF LIMITED INCOME?-AND.
- (4) TO QUALIFY FOR A SHELTERED HOUSING LOAN THE OWNER OF A SINGLE UNIT PROPERTY:
- (I) MUST OWN THE PROPERTY FOR WHICH THE LOAN IS MADE AND RESIDE IN THE PROPERTY AFTER COMPLETION OF THE REHABILITATION:
- (II) MUST AGREE TO PROVIDE SHELTER, MEALS AND ASSISTANCE WITH DAILY ACTIVITIES TO NOT MORE THAN 15 ELDERLY, DISABLED OR HANDICAPPED PERSONS WHO QUALIFY AS FAMILIES OF LIMITED INCOME; AND
- (III) MUST DEMONSTRATE THAT THE PROPERTY WILL BE CERTIFIED BY THE APPROPRIATE GOVERNING AGENCY TO PROVIDE SHELTERED CARE TO ELDERLY, DISABLED OR HANDICAPPED PERSONS.
- (5) THE TERMS AND PROVISIONS FOR ACCESSORY, SHARED AND SHELTERED HOUSING LOANS SHALL SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 257L(C)(6).
 - (G) RESIDENTIAL LEAD PAINT ABATEMENT PROGRAM.
- (1) THE RESIDENTIAL LEAD PAINT ABATEMENT PROGRAM IS CREATED WITHIN THE MARYLAND HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAM.
- (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL OPERATE THE PROGRAM AND MAKE LOANS FOR REHABILITATION PROJECTS FOR LEAD PAINT ABATEMENT FROM THE FUND UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
