- (A) IN THIS SECTION, THE TERM "LENDER'S INSPECTION FEE" MEANS A FEE IMPOSED BY A LENDER TO PAY FOR A VISUAL INSPECTION OF REAL PROPERTY.
- (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A LENDER MAY NOT IMPOSE A LENDER'S INSPECTION FEE IN CONNECTION WITH A LOAN SECURED BY RESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY.
- (C) A LENDER'S INSPECTION FEE MAY BE CHARGED IF THE INSPECTION IS NEEDED TO ASCERTAIN COMPLETION OF:
 - (1) CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW HOME; OR
- (2) REPAIRS, ALTERATIONS, OR OTHER WORK REQUIRED BY THE LENDER AS-A-CONDITION-TO-GRANTING-THE-LOAN.
- (D) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN APPRAISAL OF THE VALUE OF REAL PROPERTY BY A LENDER OR TO FEES IMPOSED IN CONNECTION WITH AN APPRAISAL.

ANY LENDER WHO KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF \$-12-1027 \$ 12-103, \$ 12-109.2, \$-12-1137-\$-12-1187 \$ 12-119, \$ 12,120, OR \$ 12-121 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS OR BOTH.

CHAPTER 629

(Senate Bill 419)

AN ACT concerning

Housing - Rental Housing Assistance

FOR the purpose of increasing the supply of decent, safe and sanitary rental housing for occupancy by families of lower income; providing a program of financial assistance for certain costs of acquiring, constructing, or rehabilitating rental housing; providing for the participation of political subdivisions in the production of affordable rental housing for families of lower income; generally relating to financial assistance for the development of rental housing which is affordable by families of lower income; authorizing a pilot program of rental allowance payments to certain low
