(iii) The residential school located within the Institute of Psychiatry and Human Behavior of the University Hospital.

(c) Each county board:

- (1) Is responsible for the identification of handicapped children who need special educational services[, including any school-age children in day care centers under jurisdiction of the Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities Administration]; and
- (2) Shall provide or arrange for appropriate educational facilities and services for these handicapped children.

22-201.

- (a) There is an Education Coordinating Council for State Hospitals and Juvenile Institutions. The Council is within the State Department of Education for administrative and budgetary purposes.
 - (b) (1) The council consists of 13 members.
- (2) (i) Five of the members shall be appointed by the Governor and shall be residents of this State who are not employees of any State or county government agency.
- (ii) Each of these members serves for a term of 5 years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. These terms are staggered as required by the terms of the members serving on July 1, 1978.
- (iii) Each of these members may be reappointed but may not serve more than two full 5-year terms.
- (3) The following officials shall serve ex officio and each may designate someone to serve in his place:
 - (i) The State Superintendent of Schools;
- (ii) The Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene;
- (iii) The Director of the Juvenile Services Administration;
- (iv) The Assistant Secretary for Mental Health, [Mental Retardation,] Addictions and Developmental Disabilities;
- (v) The Director of the [Mental Retardation
 and] Developmental Disabilities Administration;
