SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

13-613.

(a) (1) The owner of any vehicle described in paragraph (2) of this subsection may apply to the Administration for the assignment to that vehicle of a special, personalized registration number.

(2) This section applies only as to:

- (i) A Class A (passenger) vehicle;
- (ii) A Class D (motorcycle) vehicle;
- (iii) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a 3/4 ton or less manufacturer's rated capacity; [or]
- (IV) A CLASS L (HISTORIC) VEHICLE; OR
- [(iv)] (V) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
