(F) FAILURE TO REPORT PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL RESULT IN IMPOSITION OF A CIVIL PENALTY OF UP TO \$5,000 BY A CIRCUIT COURT OF THIS STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

FOR the purpose of imposing a certain limit on noneconomic losses damages in any--action-for-personal-injury certain actions for personal injury; permitting--the--introduction--into evidence--of--certain--benefits--the-plaintiff-receives-as-a result-of-the-personal-injury certain--injuries--requiring allowing the periodic payments of certain future damages in an award certain awards for--damages for--personal--injury; requiring--the--trier--of--fact--to--itemize--the--award--in--a certain-manner;--requiring--the--claimant--and--defendant--in--a medical-malpractice-action--to--file--a--certificate--of--a qualified-expert-within-a-certain-period;--providing--for--the dismissal-or-default-judgment-of-a-claim-if-a-certificate-of-a-qualified-expert-is-not--filed; allowing the periodic payment of certain future economic damages in an award for personal injury; requiring the trier of fact to itemize the award in a certain manner; providing for the admissibility of certain evidence after a certain time; requiring certain insurers to submit certain information to the Insurance Commissioner; requiring the Insurance Commissioner to make certain reports by a specific time; providing for the termination of certain requirements at a specific time; and generally relating to tort medical-malpractice personal injury claims, adjudication procedures, and award of damages.
