## CHAPTER 650

(Senate Bill 77)

AN ACT concerning

Senatorial Scholarships - Permitted Uses

FOR the purpose of altering the qualification requirements for recipients of senatorial scholarships; altering the permissible uses of senatorial scholarship awards; altering the conditions for the award, duration, and continued use of senatorial scholarship awards; and generally relating to the award and use of senatorial scholarships.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

18-402.

- (a) (1) [Each] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, EACH applicant for a senatorial scholarship shall:
- (i) Take a competitive examination administered by the State Scholarship Board; and
- (ii) Be accepted for admission in the regular undergraduate, graduate, or professional program at an eligible institution; or be enrolled in a 2-year terminal certificate program in which the course work is acceptable for transfer credit for an accredited baccalaureate program in an eligible institution.
