- PROGRAM IF THE STUDENT OTHERWISE MEETS THE CONDITIONS OF PARAGRAPHS (1) AND (2) OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- (2) SHALL COMPLETE THE PROGRAM WITHIN THE LENGTH OF TIME PRESCRIBED BY THE INSTITUTION FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE PROGRAM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

(Senate Bill 79)

AN ACT concerning

Liens on Motor Vehicles

FOR the purpose of clarifying-that-if-a-motor-vehicle--is--stored after--towing,--the-storage-fees-of-a-third-party-holder-may be-collected-during-the-distribution-of-the--proceeds--of--a lien--sale-of-the-motor-vehicle-under-certain-circumstances; altering a provision of law to provide that if certain property is stored, storage fees of a certain person may not exceed a specific amount; providing that certain exclusions or limitations of storage fees do not apply to certain persons; repealing an obsolete provision; and generally relating to liens on motor vehicles.
