

(d) Nothing in this section precludes or limits admissibility of evidence of chemical analysis which is obtained as provided in § 16-205.1(c) of the Transportation Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 653

(Senate Bill 163)

AN ACT concerning

Food Establishments - Regulation

FOR the purpose of providing for certain orders to enforce the Maryland Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act; providing for certain criminal and civil penalties for violations of the Maryland Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act; and generally relating to the enforcement of the Maryland Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - Environmental

4-261.

(A) IF THE DEPARTMENT BELIEVES THAT A PERSON IS VIOLATING ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE DEPARTMENT MAY HAVE THE PERSON SERVED WITH A WRITTEN ORDER THAT DIRECTS THE PERSON SERVED TO ABATE THE VIOLATION WITHIN A TIME SPECIFIED IN THE ORDER.
