SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 1 - Rules of Interpretation

(a) In this Code and any rule, regulation, or directive adopted under it, "legal holiday" means:

(2) January 15, for Dr. Martin Luther King, [Jr's] JR.'S birthday;

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(n) (2) This license may be issued in Harford County to an applicant for a bona fide hotel which (i) is an establishment for the accommodation of the public, providing services ordinarily found in hotels[,]; AND (ii) is equipped with no fewer than 25 rooms, a lobby with a registration and mail desk and seating facilities, and a dining room which serves full-course meals at least twice daily. This license in a hotel permits sale at bars or counters, but not liquor, beer, or wine for consumption off
