

(E) -- IN CHARLES COUNTY, TRANSFER OF AN OFF-SALE LIQUOR AN  
ISSUANCE, RENEWAL, OR TRANSFER OF AN OFF-SALE ALCOHOLIC  
BEVERAGES LICENSE DOES NOT REQUIRE DEPARTMENT APPROVAL.

4-306-

(A) -- TO APPLY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT ON THE FORM THAT THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES.

(B) -- THE APPLICATION FORM SHALL INCLUDE:

(1) -- THE APPLICANT'S NAME AND ADDRESS;

(2) -- THE LOCATION OF THE FOOD ESTABLISHMENT FOR WHICH APPLICATION IS MADE;

(3) -- THE TYPE OF FOOD ESTABLISHMENT THAT THE APPLICANT PROPOSES TO OPERATE, AND

(4) -- ANY OTHER INFORMATION THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES.

4-307-

(A) -- TO QUALIFY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL:

(1) -- COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE AND THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE;

(2) -- AGREE TO PERMIT ACCESS TO THE FOOD ESTABLISHMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF ANY INSPECTION PERMITTED OR REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, AND

(3) -- PAY THE LICENSE FEE ASSESSED UNDER SECTION 4-308 OF THIS SUBTITLE, UNLESS EXEMPTED FROM THE FEE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) -- BEFORE ISSUING A LICENSE, THE DEPARTMENT MAY INSPECT THE FOOD ESTABLISHMENT IDENTIFIED IN THE APPLICATION TO DETERMINE IF THE FOOD ESTABLISHMENT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A LICENSE.

(A) -- (1) -- FOR ANY LICENSE ISSUED FOR WHICH THE AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT A PROGRAM UNDER THIS SUBTITLE HAS BEEN DELEGATED TO A COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT:

(1) -- (1) -- A COUNTY GOVERNING BODY OR THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE MAY PROVIDE FOR A LICENSE FEE SCHEDULE BASED ON THE ANTICIPATED COST OF LICENSING, INSPECTING, AND REGULATING FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS AND MAY PROVIDE FOR EXEMPTIONS FROM THE LICENSE FEE SCHEDULE, AND
