CHAPTER 43

(House Bill 194)

AN ACT concerning

Election Laws - Death Notices

FOR the purpose of altering the age requirement for the reporting of names and addresses of certain deceased persons to the State Administrative Board of Election Laws by certain local health officers.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 33 - Election Code Section 3-18(a)(1) Annotated Code of Maryland (1983 Replacement Volume and 1985 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code

3-18.

- (a) Reports shall be made by the several officials in the counties and in Baltimore City at least once each month, except as provided in paragraph (3), as follows:
- (1) The Commissioner of Health of Baltimore City and the health officers of the counties shall file with the State Administrative Board of Election Laws a list of the names and residence addresses (if known) of all persons [over 17] AT LEAST 16 years of age reported deceased within the city or county since the date of the last such report.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.
