

{b}--The Secretary shall give any person served with an order under this section an opportunity for a hearing before the Secretary. The person served may be represented at the hearing by counsel.

{c}--After a hearing under this section, the Secretary may affirm, modify, or withdraw the order.

{d}--After the time set in the order for abating the violation, a person who is served with an order under this section may not violate that order.

Each licensee shall comply with the requirements of this subtitle and Subtitle 1 of this title.

{a}{1}--In each room where food is packed, preserved, or otherwise manufactured, the licensee shall have floors that are smooth, impervious, and easily cleaned.

{2}--Each licensee shall maintain, for each sex of employees:

{i}--Clothes-changing facilities;

{ii}--Wash-stations; and

{iii}--Separate-toilets.

{3}--Each licensee shall maintain drainage that is adequate to lead all waste liquids away from the building to the outside.

{4}--If a licensee supplies living quarters to employees, the licensee shall maintain quarters that:

{i}--Have waterproof roofs;

{ii}--Have tight floors;

{iii}--Are well-lighted and ventilated;

{iv}--Have an ample supply of pure drinking water within a reasonable distance; and

{v}--Allow separation of and privacy for each sex of employees.

{b}--Each licensee shall:

{1}--Keep the surroundings of the licensee's cannery or frozen-food-processing plant sanitary; and
