

(A) FOR ANY PROCUREMENT OVER \$100,000 SOLICITED AFTER JANUARY 1, 1987, EACH BIDDER OR OFFEROR AT THE TIME OF CONTRACT AWARD SHALL CERTIFY THAT:

(1) IT IS NOT DOING BUSINESS WITH OR IN SOUTH AFRICA;
OR

(2) IN THE CONDUCT OF ITS-BUSINESS-WITH-OR OPERATIONS IN SOUTH AFRICA, IT ABIDES BY THE FOLLOWING PRINCIPLES:

(I) NONSEGREGATION OF THE RACES IN ALL EATING, COMFORT, LOCKER ROOMS, AND WORK FACILITIES;

(II) EQUAL AND FAIR EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES FOR ALL EMPLOYEES;

(III) EQUAL PAY FOR ALL EMPLOYEES DOING EQUAL OR COMPARABLE WORK FOR THE SAME PERIOD OF TIME;

(IV) INITIATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF TRAINING PROGRAMS THAT WILL PREPARE BLACKS, ASIANS, AND OTHER NONWHITES IN SUBSTANTIAL NUMBERS FOR SUPERVISORY, ADMINISTRATIVE, CLERICAL, AND TECHNICAL JOBS;

(V) INCREASING THE NUMBER OF BLACKS, ASIANS, AND OTHER NONWHITES IN MANAGEMENT AND SUPERVISORY POSITIONS; AND

(VI) IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF EMPLOYEES' LIVES OUTSIDE THE WORK ENVIRONMENT IN SUCH AREAS AS HOUSING, TRANSPORTATION, SCHOOLING, RECREATION, AND HEALTH FACILITIES.

(B) ANY BIDDER OR OFFEROR WHO WILLFULLY VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR MISREPRESENTS ANY INFORMATION CONTAINED IN A CERTIFICATION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 MONTHS.

(c)--THIS--SUBTITLE--MAY--NOT--BE--CONSTRUED--TO--APPLY--TO--REVENUE CONTRACTS--OF--THE--MARYLAND--PORT--ADMINISTRATION--OR--THE--STATE AVIATION--ADMINISTRATION;

(1) THE PROCUREMENT IS ESSENTIAL OR IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE STATE; AND

(2) THERE IS NO OTHER KNOWN SOURCE FOR THE PROCUREMENT AT A REASONABLE COST.
