

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 399 of the Acts of 1985

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That acquisitions of human, cultural, social, and educational services by the Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities Administration of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall be exempted from the provisions of the State Procurement Law until July 1, [1986] 1987.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.
