FOR the purpose of excluding chair lifts, rope tows, t bars, j bars, and other devices used to transport skiers uphill from the definition of amusement ride ~~in order that those devices not be subject to certain insurance requirements relating to amusement rides; and generally relating to amusement park safety; defining a certain term; establishing certain insurance requirements for ski lifts; and generally relating to insurance for ski lifts.~~
