(2) AT A MEDICAL FACILITY OR CLINIC THAT IS OPERATED ON A NONPROFIT BASIS;

(3) AT A HEALTH CENTER THAT OPERATES ON A CAMPUS OF AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION; OR

(4) AT A PUBLIC HEALTH FACILITY, A MEDICAL FACILITY UNDER CONTRACT WITH A STATE OR LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT, OR A FACILITY FUNDED WITH PUBLIC FUNDS.

(a) (1) In addition to the powers set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board may:

(1) Adopt rules and regulations to:

1. Carry out the provisions of this title;
or

2. Regulate the performance of acupuncture, but only to the extent authorized by § 14-605 of this title; [and]

(II) AFTER CONSULTING WITH THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY, ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE DISPENSING OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS BY A LICENSED PHYSICIAN; AND

(3) Subject to the Administrative Procedure Act, deny a license to an applicant for any of the reasons that are grounds for action under § 14-504 of this title.

(2) THE COMMISSION ON RECEIPT OF A WRITTEN AND SIGNED COMPLAINT MAY INVESTIGATE AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE.

(a) In addition to the powers set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board may:

(1) [adopt] ADOPT rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this title; AND

(2) AFTER CONSULTING WITH THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY, ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE DISPENSING OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS BY A LICENSED PODIATRIST-; AND

(3) ON RECEIPT OF A WRITTEN AND SIGNED COMPLAINT, INVESTIGATE AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE.
