- [(3)(i)] (E) THE APPLICANT FOR LICENSURE AS A LICENSED NUTRITIONIST SHALL:
- (1) MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION; OR
- (1) (1) Have received a master's or doctoral degree from [an accredited institution] A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY ACCREDITED BY A REGIONAL ACCREDITING BODY RECOGNIZED BY THE COUNCIL ON POST-SECONDARY ACCREDITATION in nutritional sciences (with emphasis in human nutrition), food and nutrition, dietetics, human nutrition, food-service-management, community nutrition, public health nutrition, or equivalent training approved by the Board; and
- [(ii)] (2) (3) (11) 1. Have satisfactorily completed a program of supervised clinical OR RESEARCH experience [or] IN SATISFACTION OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MASTER'S OR DOCTORAL DEGREE; OR
- (3) (II) (2. HAVE SATISFACTORILY COMPLETED a comparable experience approved by the Board.
- [(e)] (F) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, the applicant must pass an examination approved by the Board under this subtitle.
- [(f)] (G) The applicant shall meet any other qualifications or requirements that the Board establishes for license applicants.

- (a) An applicant for a license shall:
- (1) Submit an application to the Board on the form that the Board requires;
 - (2) Pay the application fee set by the Board; and
- (3) Provide proof of passing an examination approved by the Board.
- (b) In addition to any other requirements of this section, an applicant who is or has been licensed in another state or country shall submit proof of good standing as a licensed dietitian OR LICENSED NUTRITIONIST in that state or country or
