[(e)] (F) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, the applicant must pass an examination approved by the Board under this subtitle.

[(f)] (G) The applicant shall meet any other qualifications or requirements that the Board establishes for license applicants.

4.5-303.

(a) An applicant for a license shall:

(1) Submit an application to the Board on the form that the Board requires;

(2) Pay the application fee set by the Board; and

(3) Provide proof of passing an examination approved by the Board.

(b) In addition to any other requirements of this section, an applicant who is or has been licensed in another state or country shall submit proof of good standing as a licensed dietitian OR LICENSED NUTRITIONIST in that state or country or
