SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 7-201(t), (u), and (v), respectively, of Article - Health - Environmental of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7-201(u), (v), and (w), respectively.

~~(2) --- "Solid waste" does not include solid or dissolved material in domestic sewage or in irrigation return flows.~~

(T) (1) "SOLID WASTE" MEANS ANY:

(I) ABANDONED MATERIAL OR SUBSTANCE WHICH IS DISPOSED OF, BURNED, OR INCINERATED OR ACCUMULATED, STORED, OR TREATED BEFORE OR IN LIEU OF BEING DISPOSED OF, BURNED, OR INCINERATED;

(II) MATERIAL OR SUBSTANCE WHICH IS RECYCLED OR ACCUMULATED, STORED, OR TREATED BEFORE RECYCLING; OR
