WHEREAS, The General Assembly recognizes the need to establish the Maryland Small Business Extension Service Center Program; now, therefore,

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- Article 41 Governor Executive and Administrative Departments

MARYLAND SMALL BUSINESS EXTENSION SERVICE CENTER PROGRAM 266FF-1.

- (A) (1) THERE IS A MARYLAND SMALL BUSINESS EXTENSION SERVICE CENTER PROGRAM WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT.
- (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL FOSTER, SUPPORT, AND ASSIST THE ECONOMIC GROWTH AND REVITALIZATION OF SMALL BUSINESS IN MARYLAND BY COORDINATING THE EFFORTS OF SMALL BUSINESS EXTENSION SERVICES THROUGHOUT THE STATE.
- (B) (1) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING TERMS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (2) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE MARYLAND SMALL BUSINESS EXTENSION SERVICE CENTER PROGRAM.
- (3) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT.
- (4) "SMALL BUSINESS" MEANS ANY MARYLAND BUSINESS CONCERN THAT IS INDEPENDENTLY OWNED AND OPERATED AND IS NOT DOMINANT IN ITS FIELD OR INDUSTRY.
