AN ACT concerning

Domiciliary Care Facilities Board

FOR the purpose of creating the Domiciliary Care Facilities Board as an interagency group; designating the membership, composition, and the chairperson of the Board; requiring certain executive departments to participate in the Board's functions in a certain manner; authorizing the Board to review, approve, and make policy regarding domiciliary care facilities; requiring the Board to report annually to the Governor and the General Assembly; and generally relating to the responsibilities of the Domiciliary Care Facilities Board.
