(II) ASSISTANCE IN THE EMBALMING OF AT LEAST 25 DEAD HUMAN BODIES: AND

(III) COMPLETION OF 2,000 WORKING HOURS IN A LICENSED FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT UNDER THE DIRECT OR INDIRECT SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED MORTICIAN. SUPERVISION MAY INCLUDE INSTRUCTION BY OTHER LICENSED MORTICIANS EMPLOYED OR SUPERVISED BY THE SPONSOR.

- (5) ON TERMINATION OF THE SPONSOR-APPRENTICE RELATIONSHIP, BOTH THE SPONSOR AND THE APPRENTICE SHALL INDEPENDENTLY NOTIFY THE BOARD OF:
 - (I) THE DATE OF TERMINATION;
- (II) THE NAME, DATE, AND PLACE OF DEATH OF EACH FUNERAL SERVICE AND EMBALMING THAT THE APPRENTICE PARTICIPATED IN; AND
- (III) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF WORKING HOURS OF PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE COMPLETED BY THE APPRENTICE.
- (D) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, THE APPLICANT SHALL PASS AN EXAMINATION GIVEN BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(b) The Board shall give examinations to applicants [once] TWICE each year, at the times and places that the Board determines.

- (a) An individual shall obtain an apprentice license from the Board before beginning an apprenticeship in this State.
- (b) An applicant for an apprentice license shall pay to the Board a fee of \$10.
- (C) AN APPLICANT FOR AN APPRENTICE LICENSE MUST BE AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD.
- [(c)] (D) While the license is effective, an apprentice license authorizes the licensee to assist a licensed mortician in the practice of mortuary science only as part of a training program to become a licensed mortician.
