

(1) ANY HEALTH-CARE-FACILITY PERSON THAT PROVIDES OR HOLDS ITSELF HIMSELF OUT AS PROVIDING COMPREHENSIVE PHYSICAL REHABILITATION SERVICES ON AN OUT-PATIENT BASIS; OR

(2) A HOSPITAL THAT IS LICENSED AS A SPECIAL REHABILITATION HOSPITAL UNDER SUBTITLE 3 OF THIS TITLE.

(D) (1) "HEALTH CARE FACILITY"--:

(1)- INCLUDES ANY FACILITY DEFINED IN § 19-101(E) OF THIS TITLE; BUT,

(2) "HEALTH CARE FACILITY" DOES NOT INCLUDE A HOME HEALTH AGENCY THAT IS LICENSED UNDER SUBTITLE 4 OF THIS TITLE.

(E) "SPECIALIZED REHABILITATION PROGRAM" MEANS ANY OF THE SPECIALTY PROGRAMS THAT THE COMMISSION ON ACCREDITATION OF REHABILITATION FACILITIES ACCREDITS, INCLUDING:

(1) SPINAL CORD INJURY PROGRAMS;

(2) HEAD INJURY PROGRAMS; AND

(3) INFANT AND EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENTAL PROGRAMS.

A COMPREHENSIVE REHABILITATION FACILITY SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE BEFORE THE FACILITY MAY PROVIDE:

(1) COMPREHENSIVE PHYSICAL REHABILITATION SERVICES;

OR

(2) ANY SPECIALIZED REHABILITATION PROGRAM.

19-1203.

(A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A SPECIAL REHABILITATION HOSPITAL THAT IS LICENSED UNDER SUBTITLE 3 OF THIS TITLE.

(B) ANY HEALTH-CARE-FACILITY PERSON THAT PROVIDES OR HOLDS ITSELF HIMSELF OUT AS PROVIDING COMPREHENSIVE PHYSICAL REHABILITATION SERVICES ON AN OUT-PATIENT BASIS SHALL OBTAIN A COMPREHENSIVE REHABILITATION LICENSE BEFORE THE FACILITY PERSON MAY PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE PHYSICAL REHABILITATION SERVICES IN THE STATE.

(C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A COMPREHENSIVE REHABILITATION LICENSE TO ANY HEALTH--CARE--FACILITY PERSON FOR WHICH WHOM A COMPREHENSIVE REHABILITATION LICENSE IS REQUIRED IF THE FACILITY PERSON:

(1) SUBMITS AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM ESTABLISHED AND PROVIDED FOR THE SECRETARY;
