- (I) ANY CONTRACT OR POLICY ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THIS STATE TO THE EMPLOYER OF THE INSURED BY A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE INSURANCE PLAN OR AN INSURANCE COMPANY WHICH PROVIDES GROUP HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO THE EMPLOYEES OF THE EMPLOYER ON AN EXPENSE INCURRED BASIS; OR
- (II) ANY CONTRACT BETWEEN THE EMPLOYER OF THE INSURED AND A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION CERTIFIED UNDER TITLE 19, SUBTITLE 7 OF THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE WHICH PROVIDES GROUP HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS OFFERED TO THE INSURED EMPLOYEES OF THE EMPLOYER.
- (4) "INSURED" MEANS AN EMPLOYEE WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE AND COVERED UNDER A GROUP CONTRACT FOR A PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN 3 MONTHS.
- (B) EVERY GROUP CONTRACT SHALL PROVIDE CONTINUATION BENEFITS MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- (C) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, THE GROUP CONTRACT SHALL PROVIDE CONTINUATION BENEFITS TO AN INSURED AFTER AN APPLICABLE CHANGE IN STATUS.
- (D) ANY CONTINUATION COVERAGE WHICH IS ELECTED BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE INSURED UNDER THE GROUP CONTRACT SHALL BE FOR A PERIOD BEGINNING ON THE DATE OF THE APPLICABLE CHANGE IN STATUS AND ENDING ON THE EARLIEST OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- (1) 18 MONTHS AFTER THE DATE OF THE APPLICABLE CHANGE IN STATUS;
- (2) THE DATE ON WHICH THE INSURED FAILS TO MAKE TIMELY PAYMENT OF ANY AMOUNT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (E)(2) OF THIS SECTION;
- (3) THE DATE ON WHICH THE INSURED BECOMES ELIGIBLE FOR HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS UNDER A AN INSURED OR SELF INSURED GROUP HEALTH BENEFIT PROGRAM OR PLAN OTHER THAN THE GROUP CONTRACT WHICH IS:
  - (I) WRITTEN ON AN EXPENSE INCURRED BASIS; OR
  - (II) WITH A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION;
- (4) THE DATE ON WHICH THE INSURED BECOMES ENTITLED TO BENEFITS UNDER TITLE XVIII OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT; OR
- (5) THE DATE ON WHICH THE INSURED ACCEPTS HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL COVERAGE UNDER ANY NONGROUP CONTRACT OR POLICY:
  - (I) WRITTEN ON AN EXPENSE INCURRED BASIS; OR
  - (II) WITH A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION;
