

PROVISION OF LAW, THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS MAY PERFORM DELEGATED MEDICAL ACTS WITHOUT A LICENSE OR JOB DESCRIPTION:

(1) A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT STUDENT IN A TRAINING PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE BOARD AND COMMITTEE, WHILE PERFORMING THE DELEGATED MEDICAL ACTS AT ANY OFFICE OF A LICENSED PHYSICIAN, HOSPITAL, CLINIC, RELATED INSTITUTION, OR SIMILAR FACILITY, OR

(2) A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT EMPLOYED IN THE SERVICE OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT WHILE PERFORMING DUTIES INCIDENT TO THAT EMPLOYMENT.

14-5-303.

(A) TO QUALIFY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

(B) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER.

(C) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE FLUENT IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE.

(D) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD.

(E) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE A GRADUATE OF A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT TRAINING PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE BOARD AND COMMITTEE.

(F) (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, THE APPLICANT SHALL PASS AN EXAMINATION SELECTED BY THE BOARD AND COMMITTEE AND GIVEN BY THE BOARD. HOWEVER, THE BOARD AND COMMITTEE MAY ACCEPT AN EXAMINATION GIVEN BY A NATIONAL CERTIFYING ORGANIZATION IN SATISFACTION OF THIS REQUIREMENT.

(2) (I) AN APPLICANT MAY BE GRANTED A LICENSE WITHOUT MEETING THE EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT BUT MUST PASS THE EXAMINATION APPROVED BY BOARD AND COMMITTEE WITHIN 2 YEARS OF BECOMING LICENSED.

(II) THE BOARD AND COMMITTEE MAY ESTABLISH A REASONABLE GRACE PERIOD FOR MEETING THE EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT.

(III) A LICENSE ISSUED TO ANY APPLICANT SUBSEQUENTLY FAILING TO MEET THE EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT SHALL BE NULL AND VOID.

(IV) IN APPROVING ANY JOB DESCRIPTION UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD AND COMMITTEE MAY TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION THE FACT THAT A LICENSEE HAS NOT YET MET THE EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT.

(A) BEFORE ANY PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT MAY PERFORM ANY DELEGATED MEDICAL ACT, THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT SHALL SUBMIT JOINTLY WITH ANY SUPERVISING PHYSICIAN A JOB DESCRIPTION TO THE BOARD AND COMMITTEE.
