- MEDICAL EXAMINERS AND THE BOARD THAT REGULATES THE OTHER HEALTH OCCUPATION.
- (2) IF THE TWO BOARDS CANNOT AGREE ON A PROPOSED RULE OR REGULATION. THE PROPOSAL SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE SECRETARY FOR A FINAL DECISION.

14.5-302.

- (A) TO PERFORM DELEGATED MEDICAL ACTS WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THIS TITLE, A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT SHALL OBTAIN AN APPROVED JOB DESCRIPTION FROM THE BOARD.
- (B) TO APPLY FOR A JOB DESCRIPTION, A PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT SHALL:
 - (1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE BOARD:
- (I) LISTING ALL MEDICAL ACTS TO BE DELEGATED TO THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT AND THE SUPERVISION TO BE PERFORMED;
- (II) DESCRIBING THE SETTING IN WHICH THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT SHALL PRACTICE AND THE QUALIFICATIONS OF THE SUPERVISING PHYSICIAN;
- PROVIDED TO THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT AND THE SUPERVISION TO BE PROVIDED BY THE SUPERVISING PHYSICIAN; AND
- (IV) PROVIDING OTHER INFORMATION DEEMED NECESSARY BY THE BOARD OR THE COMMITTEE;
 - (2) SUBMIT TO THE BOARD THE FEE SET BY THE BOARD; AND
- (3) COMPLY WITH ALL OTHER REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD.
 - (C) THE COMMITTEE SHALL:
- (1) EVALUATE THE QUALIFICATIONS OF THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT FOR DELEGATED MEDICAL ACTS TO BE PERFORMED UNDER THE JOB DESCRIPTION;
- (2) CONDUCT A PERSONAL INTERVIEW OF THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT AND THE SUPERVISING PHYSICIAN; AND
- OR MODIFICATION OF ANY APPEICATION FOR A JOB DESCRIPTION.
 - (D) ON REVIEW OF THE COMMITTEE'S RECOMMENDATION, THE BOARD:
- (1) MAY APPROVE, MODIFY, OR DENY A REQUEST FOR CERTIFICATION; AND
