

INVOLVED IN A VEHICLE SALE, INCLUDING THE COMPLETION OF THE SALES CONTRACT, THE ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY REGISTRATION PLATES AND A TEMPORARY REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE, AND DELIVERY OF THE VEHICLE, AT THE DEALER'S FIXED LOCATION AS SHOWN IN THE DEALER'S APPLICATION FOR THE LICENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1986.

CHAPTER 763

(House Bill 1013)

AN ACT concerning

Exposure to infectious Contagious Diseases - Notification and-Benefits
for Fire Fighters and, Emergency
Medical Technicians, and Rescue Squadmen

FOR the purpose of requiring certain physicians to notify certain paid and volunteer fire fighters and, emergency medical technicians, and rescue squadmen if the fire fighter or, emergency medical technician, or rescue squadman comes into contact with certain patients with infectious contagious diseases; requiring that such notice be made within a certain period of time, include certain written protocol confirmation, and be conducted in a certain confidential fashion; establishing--the--entitlement-of-certain-paid-and-volunteer-fire-fighters-to-receive--occupational--disability benefits--and--certain--medical--treatment--if-exposed-to-an-infectious--disease-and-notified-as--required; establishing entitlement--to--an--a-certain occupational-infectious-death benefit; defining a certain term; and generally relating to notification and--benefits--for of fire fighters and, emergency medical technicians, and rescue squadmen exposed to infectious contagious diseases.
