- (3) THE BOARD SHALL NOTIFY THE APPLICANT OF ELIGIBILITY FOR EXAMINATION AT LEAST 15 DAYS BEFORE THE EXAMINATION.
- (4) ANY APPLICANT WHO FAILS TO APPEAR FOR A SCHEDULED EXAMINATION AND STILL DESIRES TO TAKE THE EXAMINATION SHALL FILE A NEW APPLICATION AND PAY A NEW FEE. THE BOARD MAY WAIVE THIS REQUIREMENT FOR GOOD CAUSE.
- (D) (1) THE BOARD SHALL HOLD LICENSE EXAMINATIONS ON THE 4TH FRIDAY OF EVERY MONTH AT 12 NOON IN THE BOARD'S OFFICE.
- (2) THE LICENSE EXAMINATION SHALL REQUIRE KNOWLEDGE
 OF ALL APPLICABLE CODES OR OTHER RULES, LAWS, OR PRINCIPLES OF
 ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS.
 - (3) THE QUESTIONS SHALL BE OBTAINED FROM A LIST OF QUESTIONS SUBMITTED BY THE UNIFORM ELECTRICAL LICENSING EXAMINATION COMMITTEE.
 - (E) (1) APPLICANTS SHALL FILE THEIR APPLICATIONS WITH THE BOARD AT LEAST 45 DAYS BEFORE THE EXAMINATION DATE.
 - (2) EACH APPLICANT SHALL TAKE AND PASS THE OBJECTIVE WRITTEN EXAMINATION TO DETERMINE THEIR FITNESS FOR A MASTER ELECTRICIAN'S LICENSE.
 - (3) THE PASSING GRADE FOR THE EXAMINATION SHALL BE 70 PERCENT AND THE NOTICE FOR THE EXAMINATION SHALL SPECIFY THE PASSING GRADE.
 - (F) (1) WITHIN 45 DAYS AFTER THE EXAMINATION, THE BOARD SHALL INFORM THE APPLICANT, IN WRITING, WHETHER OR NOT THE APPLICANT PASSED THE APPLICATION.
 - (2) IF THE APPLICANT PASSED, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE, SUBJECT TO COMPLIANCE BY THE APPLICANT WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (J) OF THIS SECTION.
 - (3) THE LICENSE SHALL BE ISSUED ONLY IN THE PERSONAL NAME OF THE LICENSEE OR TO A LICENSEE AS A QUALIFIED AGENT ASSIGNED TO A SINGLE PERSON, FIRM, OR CORPORATION BY WHICH THE LICENSEE IS PRINCIPALLY EMPLOYED.
 - (G) (1) IF THE BOARD REJECTS AN APPLICANT'S APPLICATION FOR A MASTER ELECTRICIAN'S LICENSE, THE APPLICANT MAY APPEAL TO A BOARD OF ARBITRATION.
 - (2) THE BOARD OF ARBITRATION SHALL CONSIST OF 3 PERSONS: ONE PERSON SELECTED BY THE APPLICANT; ONE PERSON SELECTED BY THE BOARD; AND A THIRD PERSON SELECTED BY THE 2 PERSONS NAMED TO THE BOARD OF ARBITRATION BY THE APPLICANT AND BOARD, RESPECTIVELY.
