(House Bill 1196)

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County - Office of the State's Attorney PG 305-86

FOR the purpose of altering the salaries of the State's Attorney, the deputy State's attorney, the assistant State's attorneys, and the administrative assistant in Prince George's County; increasing the number of assistant State's attorneys; providing—that—certain—work—classifications—in the—office—of—the—Prince—George's—County—State's—Attorney are—subject—to—the—State's—Attorney's—control—and—are entitled—to—all—benefits—that—are—provided—for—county employees—under—the—Prince—George's—County—merit—system providing for the applicability of this Act; and generally relating to the office of the State's Attorney in Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
