(II) TECHNICAL SESSIONS OF PROFESSIONAL SOCIETIES OR CHAPTERS:

(III) COLLEGE COURSES;

(IV) FORMAL, ORGANIZED, IN-FIRM EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS OF CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTING FIRMS;

(V) SEMINARS PROVIDED BY GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES;

AND

(VI) OTHER SEMINARS OR SYMPOSIUMS RELATED TO THE PRACTICE OF ACCOUNTANCY; AND

- (4) ENSURE THAT PROGRAMS, APPROVED FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS, ARE AVAILABLE AT REASONABLE INTERVALS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.
 - (C) CONTINUING EDUCATION COMMITTEE.
- (1) THE BOARD MAY APPOINT A CONTINUING EDUCATION COMMITTEE TO ASSIST THE BOARD IN CARRYING OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- (2) EACH COMMITTEE MEMBER SHALL BE A LICENSED CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT.
- (3) THE DUTIES OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE AS ASSIGNED BY THE BOARD.
 - (D) REPORTING SYSTEM.

THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE FOR A SYSTEM FOR REPORTING AND RECORDING THE PROGRAM HOURS EARNED BY EACH LICENSEE. HOWEVER, THE BOARD MAY NOT REQUIRE A LICENSEE TO SUBMIT SCORES OR GRADES EARNED FROM THE LICENSEE'S PARTICIPATION IN A PROGRAM.

- 2-313. INACTIVE STATUS.
 - (A) IN GENERAL.

THE BOARD SHALL PLACE A LICENSEE ON INACTIVE STATUS AND ISSUE AN INACTIVE STATUS CERTIFICATE TO THE LICENSEE, IF THE LICENSEE:

- (1) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION FOR INACTIVE STATUS ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD PROVIDES;
- (2) PAYS TO THE BOARD AN INACTIVE STATUS APPLICATION FEE NOT EXCEEDING \$40, AS SET BY THE BOARD; AND
- (3) EXCEPT FOR THE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS SET UNDER § 2-312 OF THIS SUBTITLE, QUALIFIES FOR AN ACTIVE LICENSE.
