- (2) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION FOR REACTIVATION: AND
- (3) PAYS TO THE BOARD A REACTIVATION FEE IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE LICENSE RENEWAL FEE SET BY THE BOARD UNDER § 2-311 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 2-314. REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSES.

THE BOARD, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ITS REGULATIONS, MAY REINSTATE THE LICENSE OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS FAILED TO RENEW THE LICENSE FOR ANY REASON IF THE INDIVIDUAL:

- (1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED;
- (2) COMPLIES WITH ANY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENT ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD FOR THIS PURPOSE; AND
- (3) PAYS TO THE BOARD ALL PAST DUE RENEWAL FEES AND A REINSTATEMENT FEE NOT EXCEEDING \$60, AS SET BY THE BOARD.
- 2-315. DENIALS, REPRIMANDS, SUSPENSIONS, AND REVOCATIONS.

(A) GROUNDS.

SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 2-317 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD, ON THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS, MAY DENY A LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT, REPRIMAND ANY LICENSEE, OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE A LICENSE IF THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE:

- (1) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY OBTAINS OR ATTEMPTS TO OBTAIN A LICENSE FOR THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE OR FOR ANOTHER;
 - (2) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY USES A LICENSE;
- (3) UNDER THE LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES OR OF ANY STATE, IS CONVICTED OF OR PLEADS NOLO CONTENDERE TO ANY:
 - (I) FELONY; OR
- (II) ANY CRIME INVOLVING AN ELEMENT OF FRAUD OR OTHER DISHONESTY;
- (4) IS GUILTY OF FRAUD OR OTHER DISHONESTY IN THE PRACTICE OF ACCOUNTANCY;
- (5) IS GUILTY OF GROSS NEGLIGENCE IN THE PRACTICE OF ACCOUNTANCY;
- (6) VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF SUBTITLE 6 OF THIS TITLE;
- (7) HAS HAD THE RIGHT TO PRACTICE AS A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT IN ANOTHER STATE DENIED, REVOKED, OR SUSPENDED,
