

OR HAS HAD THE RENEWAL OF THAT AUTHORITY DENIED FOR ANY CAUSE OTHER THAN FAILURE TO PAY A RENEWAL FEE;

(8) HAS HAD THE RIGHT TO PRACTICE AS A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT BEFORE ANY UNIT OF THE STATE OR FEDERAL GOVERNMENT REVOKED OR SUSPENDED; OR

(9) VIOLATES A RULE OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT ADOPTED BY THE BOARD.

(B) SURRENDER OF DOCUMENTS.

ON SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF A LICENSE, THE HOLDER SHALL SURRENDER TO THE BOARD:

(1) THE HOLDER'S LICENSE CERTIFICATE; AND

(2) ANY OTHER DOCUMENT, ISSUED UNDER THIS OR ANY PRIOR LAW OF THE STATE, THAT SPECIFIES THAT THE HOLDER IS A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT, A REGISTERED CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT, OR AN ENROLLED CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT.

(C) RETURN OF DOCUMENTS.

AT THE END OF A SUSPENSION PERIOD, THE BOARD SHALL RETURN TO THE LICENSEE ANY DOCUMENT SURRENDERED UNDER THIS SECTION.

2-316. SAME -- COMMENCEMENT OF PROCEEDINGS.

ON ITS OWN INITIATIVE OR ON A WRITTEN COMPLAINT MADE TO THE BOARD BY ANY PERSON, THE BOARD MAY COMMENCE PROCEEDINGS UNDER § 2-315 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

2-317. HEARINGS.

(A) RIGHT TO HEARING.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 4 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, BEFORE THE BOARD TAKES ANY ACTION UNDER § 2-315 OF THIS SUBTITLE, IT SHALL GIVE THE INDIVIDUAL AGAINST WHOM THE ACTION IS CONTEMPLATED AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A HEARING BEFORE THE BOARD.

(B) APPLICATION OF CONTESTED CASE PROVISIONS.

THE BOARD SHALL GIVE NOTICE AND HOLD THE HEARING IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

(C) OATHS.

THE BOARD MAY ADMINISTER OATHS IN CONNECTION WITH ANY PROCEEDING UNDER THIS SECTION.
