CHAPTER 782

(House Bill 1308)

AN ACT concerning

Energy Overcharge Restitution Trust Fund
- Expenditure of Funds

FOR the purpose of requiring certain approval of budget amendments relating to funds in the Energy Overcharge Restitution Trust Fund under certain circumstances; authorizing certain expenditures from the principal of the Energy Overcharge Restitution Trust Fund; providing for the equipment, personnel, and expenses for the administration of the Energy Overcharge Restitution Trust Fund; providing for a certain report to certain committees of the General Assembly; altering certain limitations on the use of certain funds; providing certain limitations on expenditures; authorizing the Trust Fund Board of Trustees to make certain disbursements in the form of loans to certain nonprofit groups; authorizing the Board to establish certain regulations; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the Energy Overcharge Restitution Trust Fund.
