A. 1 person from a list of 3 persons submitted by the Maryland Association of Counties;

B. 1 person from a list of 3 persons submitted by the Maryland Municipal League; and

C. 1 person representing Baltimore City, nominated by the Mayor of Baltimore.

~~(ii)~~ (III) The 4 nonvoting ex officio members shall be:

1. The chairman of the Committee on Environmental Matters of the House of Delegates OR A DESIGNEE OF THE CHAIRMAN;

2. The chairman of the Committee on Appropriations of the House of Delegates OR A DESIGNEE OF THE CHAIRMAN;

3. The chairman of the Committee on Economic and Environmental Affairs of the Senate of Maryland, OR A DESIGNEE OF THE CHAIRMAN; and

4. The chairman of the Committee on Budget and Taxation of the Senate of Maryland, OR A DESIGNEE OF THE CHAIRMAN.

(b) (1) The term of the AN APPOINTED Board member ~~from--the public-~~ is 3 years.

(2) At the end of a term, the AN APPOINTED Board member ~~from-the-public~~ continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(3) The AN APPOINTED Board member ~~from-the-public~~ who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(4) The AN APPOINTED Board member ~~from--the--public~~ may serve successive terms.

(c) Except for ~~the-public~~ AN APPOINTED member of the Board, members may serve on the Board for as long as they remain in the office to which they were appointed or elected.
