

the Board of Public Works may authorize the sale of real property formerly designated for the use, support, or operation of a residential institution for mentally retarded individuals under certain circumstances; providing that proceeds from the disposition of certain real property be first applied in part to the State Annuity Bond Fund and any remaining amount be invested in a trust fund and designated in a certain manner to benefit mentally retarded individuals; and generally relating to the disposition of certain real property and the designation of certain proceeds.

SECTION--2,--AND--BE--IT--FURTHER--ENACTED, That the Laws of  
 Maryland read as follows:

Article---Health---General

2-105.

(A) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, ON THE  
 RECOMMENDATION OF THE SECRETARY, THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS MAY  
 AUTHORIZE FOR SALE ANY REAL PROPERTY THAT:

(1) IS HELD BY THE STATE, IN THE NAME OF THE  
 DEPARTMENT, OR IN THE NAME OF THE MENTAL RETARDATION AND  
 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADMINISTRATION; AND

(2) FORMERLY WAS DESIGNATED FOR THE USE, SUPPORT, OR  
 OPERATION OF A RESIDENTIAL INSTITUTION FOR MENTALLY RETARDED  
 INDIVIDUALS.
