CHAPTER 92

(House Bill 1646)

AN ACT concerning

Charles County - Sheriff's Department Pension Plan

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Charles County to modify the current retirement plan for the Charles County Sheriff's department; establishing a new pension plan for the Sheriff's department which may include the Sheriff and sworn employees of the Sheriff's department who are actively engaged in law enforcement; providing that this plan will allow for early retirement after a certain number of years of active service; and generally relating to the Sheriff's department retirement plan in Charles County.
